IMPORTANT ARRIVAL INFORMATION

All winners must be physically present at the designated venue not later than **7:30 a.m on the 25th of May 2026**. Punctuality is mandatory. Late arrival may lead to disqualification or forfeiture of participation privileges.

GUIDELINES FOR EMBARKATION OF CIVILIANS ONBOARD NIGERIAN NAVY SHIPS DURING THE NIGERIAN NAVY 70TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

General Requirements

1. Embarkation is strictly by prior authorization and accreditation.
2. All civilians must present a valid means of identification before boarding.
3. Pregnant women, medically unfit persons, and persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be allowed onboard.
4. All passengers will undergo security screening before embarkation.
5. The Commanding Officer reserves the right to deny embarkation to any person considered a safety, security, or disciplinary risk.
6. All passengers must comply with instructions issued by naval personnel at all times.
7. A mandatory safety briefing will be conducted before departure.
8. Life jackets must be worn throughout the voyage.
9. Passengers must remain within designated safe areas onboard.
10. Access to operational compartments, machinery spaces, the bridge, and communication rooms is strictly controlled and only permitted when authorized.
11. Passengers should familiarize themselves with emergency exits, muster stations, and emergency procedures.

12. Running, horseplay, leaning over rails, unauthorized climbing of ladders, and any unsafe movement onboard are prohibited.

13. Smoking is prohibited during the trip.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- ✓ The following items are not permitted onboard:
- ✓ Firearms and ammunition.
- ✓ Knives, sharp objects, and offensive weapons.
- ✓ Explosives, fireworks, and flammable materials.
- ✓ Illegal drugs and narcotics.
- ✓ Alcoholic beverages (except where expressly authorized and duly recorded).
- ✓ Dangerous chemicals or hazardous substances.
- ✓ Drones or unmanned aerial vehicles without prior approval.
- ✓ Recording devices in restricted areas.
- ✓ Pets or animals.

PROHIBITED CONDUCT

The following actions are strictly forbidden:

- ✓ Disobeying lawful instructions from naval personnel.
- ✓ Disorderly, abusive, indecent, or unruly behaviour.
- ✓ Harassment, bullying, discrimination, or inappropriate physical contact.
- ✓ Unauthorized photography or videography of sensitive equipment, personnel, or installations.
- ✓ Interfering with ship operations or handling equipment without authorization.
- ✓ Gambling, fighting, or any provocative conduct.
- ✓ Consumption of prohibited substances.
- ✓ Posting sensitive operational information, live ship movements, or restricted images on social media.
- ✓ Entering restricted areas without authorization.
- ✓ Disposing of waste or any object into the sea contrary to environmental regulations.

DRESS CODE

1. Civilians must dress decently and appropriately for a naval environment.
2. Footwear with good grip must be worn for safety reasons.
3. Clothing displaying offensive, political, extremist, or obscene content is prohibited.
